In accordance with section 124A(3) of the Education Reform Act 1988<sup>(a)</sup> (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), the Privy Council by Order dated 26th April 1993 made an instrument of government for the Thames Valley University, being a higher education corporation with respect to which Schedule 7 to the Act has effect.

Section 124A(3)(b) of the Act provides that the Privy Council may by Order modify an instrument of government of any such higher education corporation.

The Privy Council by Order dated 10th August 2010 modified the instrument of government to provide for a change of name to The University of West London.

Accordingly, Their Lordships, in exercise of the powers conferred on Them by section 124A(3)(b), are pleased to modify the instrument of government in accordance with the provision set out in the Schedule to this Order.

*SCHEDULE*

MODIFICATIONS TO THE INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT REFERRED TO IN THE FORGOING ORDER

1. In the Interpretation *delete* "'Principal" means the Vice-Chancellor and Chief Executive of the University" and *substitute* "'Vice-Chancellor" means the Principal of the University".

2. *Delete* paragraph 3(1)(b) and *substitute*:

"(b) the Vice-Chancellor, unless the Vice-Chancellor chooses not to be a member."
